While it may seem almost nit-picking to object to this application as it will clearly have no material effect on the appearance of the site nevertheless the Society does wish to register its objection to yet another example of Messrs Bugg extending incrementally the scope of planning permissions.

We have always argued that Messrs Bugg's operations are entirely inappropriate to an AONB and that they should not be allowed to expand ad infinitum. While this expansion is small and, except for additional traffic, probably of very little impact on the environment it is still further expansion of this firm's activities in the AONB to which we object in principle.
